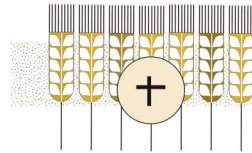
### FORMED NOW - THE FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI

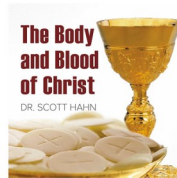
