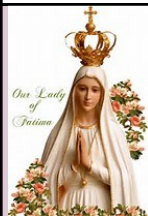

Wyoming Council of Catholic Women will hold their annual convention Thursday through Saturday, **September 9, 10 & 11, 2021.**



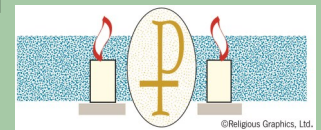

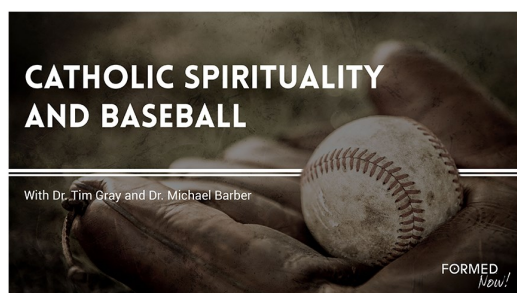
#### JOHN PAUL II IN AMERICA: UNITING A CONTINENT

#### FORMED NOW! CATHOLIC SPIRITUALITY AND BASEBALL

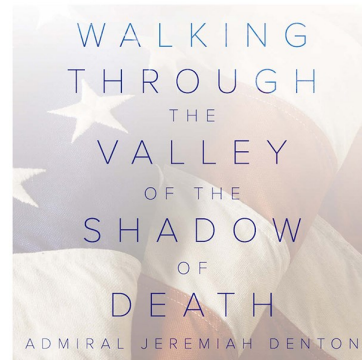
