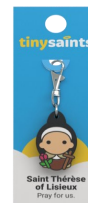
Gatherings will be held each Thursday evening from 7 to 8:30PM beginning September 9th.

Announcement from the Diocese

In the spirit of transparency, the Diocese of Cheyenne reports that Reverend Eckley Macklin (85 years old) has been restricted from public ministry due to a credible allegation of sexual abuse of a minor in the Diocese of Corpus Christi. Rev. Macklin is a priest of the Society of Our Lady of the Most Holy Trinity (SOLT). The alleged incident of abuse did not take place within the Diocese of Cheyenne; however, he served in the Diocese of Cheyenne from 2003-2015 in the parishes of St. Ann in Saratoga; St. Joseph in Lovell; St. Stephens Mission in St. Stephens; and St. Margaret in Riverton.

Anyone who has suffered sexual abuse should contact the local law enforcement agency or the Department of Family Services.
