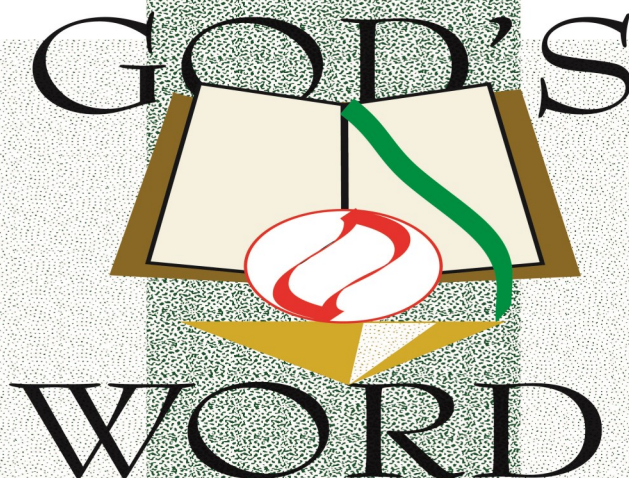

On Wednesday September 29 at 6:30 the Adult Faith Formation class will see a special video called *CHARTRES CATHEDRAL A Sacred Geometry*. This is a 60 minute video presentation about the Chartres Cathedral in Chartres, France, which is also known as the Cathedral of Our Lady of Chartres. The film highlights special architectural aspects of the cathedral, including the stained glass windows, which tell the story of creation from the beginning to the day of judgment, and the 12th century labyrinth in the nave.

The Adult Faith Formation classes are for the parents of children in the youth classes, and all other adults.

The following week the Adult Faith Formation class will resume viewing the series, "The Search", from the FORMED library.
