

The Church of God is convoked in Synod. The path, "For a Synodal Church: communion, participation, and mission," solemnly opened in Rome on October 9-10, 2021. On Sunday, October 10, 2021, Bishop Biegler followed with the diocesan opening at the Cathedral of St.




On October 22-23, 2021, the Diocese of Cheyenne will host a High School Youth Retreat, "Our Identity in Christ."
