

Our Lady of Fatíma Catholic Church Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord January 2, 2022

As a Catholic Christian Community we bring forth these guidelines regarding the Sacrament of infant Baptism. Since this is a sacrament of initiation (introduction) to the Catholic Community the following must take place: *The parents must be registered at Our Lady of Fatima, and be consistently seen attending Mass in this church.

*If this is the first child, parent (s) must attend a Baptismal Preparation class. *Godparents must be Baptized, Confirmed, and practicing Catholics. One Godparent can be of a Protestant denomination. If for good rea-son God-parents are from out of town, or another Catholic church in town, a letter from their pastor is required to state they are practicing members in good standing. *A visitation with the priest is necessary before scheduling a date for the Baptism of the child.

*Those guidelines are given in order to insure continued growth and participation in the Catholic faith and the Church community.


