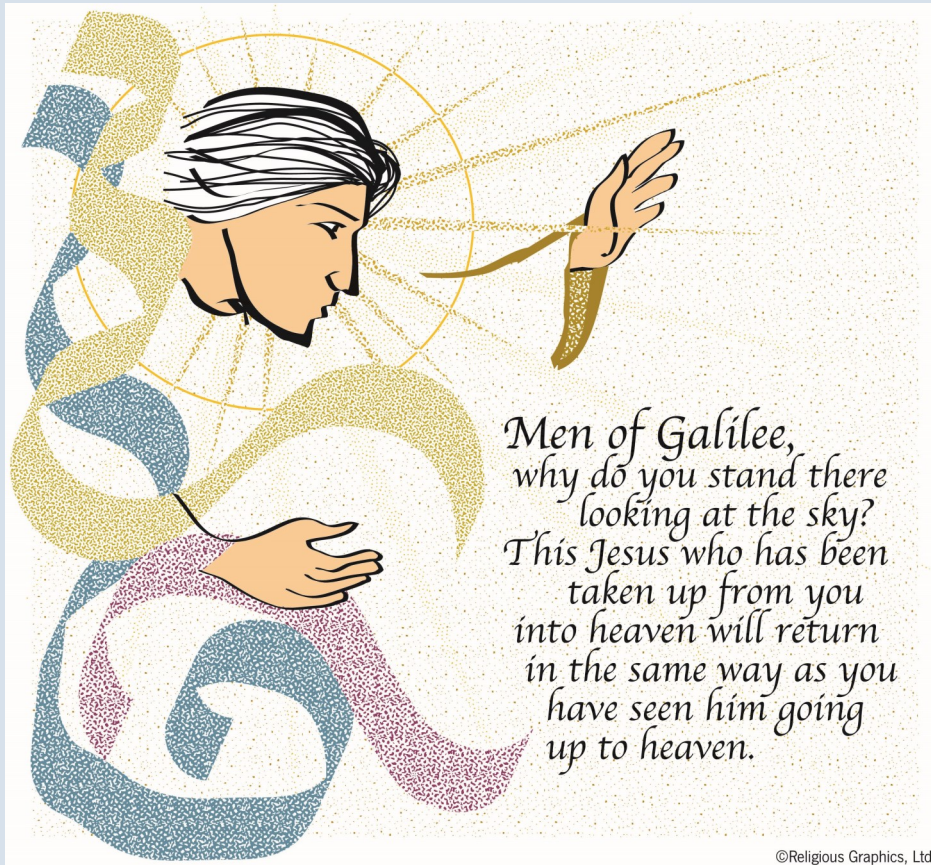

The Our Lady of Fatima Pilgrim Statue is again traveling around our parish.

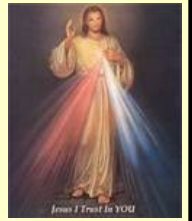

Villa Mornese Home for Girls — Tuxtia Gutierrez, Mexico

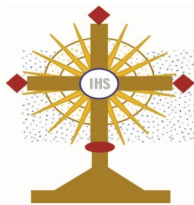

Baptism of Infants

As a Catholic Christian Community we bring forth these guidelines regarding the Sacrament of infant Baptism. Since this is a sacrament of initiation (introduction) to the Catholic Community the following must take place:

*The parents must be registered at Our Lady of Fatima, and be consistently seen attending Mass in this church.

*If this is the first child, parent (s) must attend a Baptismal Preparation class.

*Godparents must be Baptized, Confirmed, and practicing Catholics. One Godparent can be of a Protestant denomination. If for good reason God-parents are from out of town, or another Catholic church in town, a letter from their pastor is required to state they are practicing members in good standing.

*A visitation with the priest is necessary before scheduling a date for the Baptism of the child.

*Those not registered in our parish must have written permission from their pastor to have their child Baptized in our church. These guidelines are given in order to insure continued growth and participation in the Catholic faith and the Church community.

Shared Prayer and Study: **The Early History of Catholicism in Wyoming**

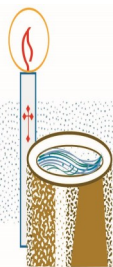
On July 5, 1840, Fr. Peter De Smet served as principal celebrant of the first Eucharistic assembly located within the territory that would eventually become Wyoming. The rendezvous outside of what today is the town of Daniel now contains a monument and small chapel commemorating this celebration, and the Diocese celebrates Eucharist at this location each July to remember this Eucharistic gathering.

The history of De Smet's arrival in Wyoming, those among whom he ministered, and the context of his time provide great insight not only into this first Eucharistic assembly but also who we are as the local Church of the Diocese of Cheyenne today. Essential to the beginnings of the Catholic Church in Wyoming is Fr. De Smet's ministry among Native communities, his eventual involvement in the federal government's establishment of the reservation system, and the shared affection and respect between some Native communities and De Smet.

To explore this history further, the Office of Pastoral Formation of the Diocese of Cheyenne will coordinate a Diocese-wide experience of prayer and study with the book, *Come, Blackrobe*.

Through our shared study, we will have the opportunity to learn about our faith, the historical forces that have contextualized our faith, and how we can understand ourselves as the Church in the Diocese of Cheyenne in contemporary times.
