Baptism of Infants

As a Catholic Christian Community we bring forth these guidelines regarding the Sacrament of infant Baptism. Since this is a Sacrament of Initiation (introduction) to the Catholic Community the following must take place:



- *The parents must be registered at Our Lady of Fatima, and be consistently seen attending Mass in this church.
- *If this is the first child, the parent (s) must attend a Baptismal Preparation class.
- *Godparents must be Baptized, Confirmed, and practicing Catholics. One Godparent is required. If for good reason the Godparent is from out of town, or another Catholic church in town, a letter from his/her pastor is required stating that he/she is a practicing member in good standing.
- *A visitation with the priest is necessary before scheduling a date for the Baptism of the child.
- *Those parents not registered in our parish must have written permission from their pastor to have their child Baptized in our church. These guidelines are given in order to insure continued growth and participation in the Catholic faith and the Church community.

Calling Wyoming college-aged youth!

The Diocese of Cheyenne is searching for charismatic young Catholics 18 and older to help with our *Totus Tuus* summer program. The missionary team will be composed of two men and two women who will spend eight weeks traveling to parishes across the great state of Wyoming to provide summer programs for children aged K-12th grades.

You must be good with kids and willing to be a little silly. You also must be a practicing Catholic, living your faith, but you do not need to be a theologian. Prior to the camp, you will receive easy-to-follow teaching materials, along with a week of practical training, as well as community building, prayer, and spiritual growth opportunities. Training will be the 3rd or 4th week in May, summer programs run from June 3-July 28. This is a missionary role, so the stipend is humble, but the experience is lifechanging. All meals and lodging are provided during your mission work.



Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion

Mandates for current Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion will expire on April 6, 2023. You must attend a training session for your



ministry to renew your mandate. For your convenience, Fr. Clark will be conducting several training and formation sessions for those who wish to serve in this capacity for our parish. The new mandate will allow you to serve in our parish for a term of three years.

Completion of this training is required for both current and prospective EMHCs. There will be separate trainings for those who wish to serve on the altar, and for those who wish to be Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to the homebound or those in facilities. If a person wishes to volunteer for both service on the altar, AND ministering to those in hospitals, nursing homes, or homebound, they must attend <u>both</u> types of trainings. All sessions will be held in the church.

EMHC for the homebound or those in facilities must have a completed, current, and approved diocesan background check, including driving approval, and completion of online safe environment training.
