

# Wyoming Council of Catholic Women Mary's Fund 2024 The fund will be divided between two projects:

Diocese of Nellore Fr. Thomas George Prakasam Development Social Service Society (PDSSS)

Diocese of Nellore Fr. Thomas George Prakasam Development Social Service Society (PDSSS) Fr. Thomas George, who previously served in the Diocese of Cheyenne, is the Executive Director of the Prakasam District. The Diocese of Nellore provides a number of charitable and humanitarian services to the poorest of the poor. The funds will help provide the most needy people (primarily women and children) with food, clean water, and goats for milk. It will also help cancer patients, make repairs to orphanages and schools, education programs (especially for girls), sanitation, and other needs. The area of the PDSSS covers over 6,800 square miles with a population of over 4.7 million people.

Diocese of Issele-Uku Fr. Godfrey Okwunka Community Action for Productivity and Economic Emancipation (CAPE)

Diocese of Issele-Uku Fr. Godfrey Okwunka Community Action for Productivity and Economic Emancipation (CAPE) Fr. Godfrey is currently serving as the Chaplain for Wyoming Catholic College. The project will benefit families in the remote part of the Delta State, which has low scale farming and trading as the major sources of income. One of the means that women use to earn money to support their families is the processing of cassava or palm oil. The project funds will be used to purchase an oil mill. They currently have to use a processing service which is expensive and reduces the amount of money they can earn. This will also create jobs for more women and youth in the community. The Mary's Fund was founded in 1958 and exists to improve the lives of women and children in countries outside the United States.
