FORMING INTENTIONAL DISCIPLES

Have you dropped your nets to follow Jesus? How are you accompanying and sharing your faith with others?

Saint Patrick's in Casper is partnering with Sherry Waddell and the Catherine of Sienna Institute (CSI) to offer a series on discipleship and evangelization. This journey of discipleship begins with a six-session *Forming Intentional Disciples* book study via Zoom on Tuesdays, beginning January 9 through February 13, 2024, \$25 per person.

A weekend course in Casper, Making Disciples 101, will follow the book study, March 8, 7-9 p.m.; March 9, 9 a.m.-9 p.m.; and March 10, 9:30 a.m.-5 p.m., \$55 per person.

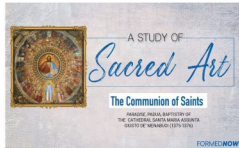
