Baptism of Infants

As a Catholic Christian Community we bring forth these guidelines regarding the Sacrament of Infant Baptism. Since this is a Sacrament of Initiation (introduction) to the Catholic Community the following must take place:



*The parents must be registered at Our Lady of Fatima, and be consistently seen attending Mass in this church.

*If this is the first child, the parent (s) must attend a Baptismal Preparation class.


*Godparents must be Baptized, Confirmed, and practicing Catholics. One Godparent is required. If for good reason the Godparent is from out of town, or another Catholic church in town, a letter from his/her pastor is required stating that he/she is a practicing member in good standing.

*A visitation with the priest is necessary before scheduling a date for the Baptism of the child.

*Those parents not registered in our parish must have written permission from their pastor to have their child Baptized in our church.

These guidelines are given in order to insure continued growth and participation in the Catholic faith and the Church community.

"Bishop Steven Biegler has requested that people do not give funds for deposit in the personal checking account of Father Thomas George or any other priest or deacon for any project because it is bad financial practice and contrary to diocesan norms. There is no mechanism to assure that funds will be utilized as specified. Also, such donations could not be claimed for tax purposes since they would not be donated to a non-profit entity. Finally, channeling monies through Fr. Thomas's or any other priest's or deacon's personal checking account could create a taxable event for them and trigger some financial transactions issues, particularly when funds are transferred abroad."





Diocese of Nellore Fr. Thomas George Prakasam Development Social Service Society (PDSSS) Fr. Thomas George, who previously served in the Diocese of Cheyenne, is the Executive Director of the Prakasam District. The Diocese of Nellore provides a number of charitable and humanitarian services to the poorest of the poor. The funds will help provide the most needy people (primarily women and children) with food, clean water, and goats for milk. It will also help cancer patients, make repairs to orphanages and schools, education programs (especially for girls), sanitation, and other needs. The area of the PDSSS covers over 6,800 square miles with a population of over 4.7 million people.

Diocese of Issele-Uku Fr. Godfrey Okwunka Community Action for Productivity and Economic Emancipation (CAPE)

Diocese of Issele-Uku Fr. Godfrey Okwunka Community Action for Productivity and Economic Emancipation (CAPE) Fr. Godfrey is currently serving as the Chaplain for Wyoming Catholic College. The project will benefit families in the remote part of the Delta State, which has low scale farming and trading as the major sources of income. One of the means that women use to earn money to support their families is the processing of cassava or palm oil. The project funds will be used to purchase an oil mill. They currently have to use a processing service which is expensive and reduces the amount of money they can earn. This will also create jobs for more women and youth in the community. The Mary's Fund was founded in 1958 and exists to improve the lives of women and children in countries outside the United States.
