There is no mechanism to assure that funds will be utilized as specified. Also, such dona- tions could not be claimed for tax purposes since they would not be donated to a non-profit entity. Finally, channeling monies through Fr. Thomas's or any other priest's or deacon's personal checking account could create a taxable event for them and trigger some financial transactions issues, particu- larly when funds are transferred abroad."
