As a Christian Community we bring forth these guidelines regarding the Sacrament of Infant Baptism. Since this is a Sacrament of Initiation (introduction) to the Catholic Community the following must take place:



\*The parents must be registered at Our Lady of Fatima, and be consistently seen attending Mass in this church.

\*If this is the first child, the parent (s) must attend a Baptismal Preparation class.

\*Godparents must be Baptized, Confirmed, and practicing Catholics. One Godparent is required. If for good reason the Godparent is from out of town, or another Catholic church in town, a letter from his/her pastor is required stating that he/she is a practicing member in good standing.

\*A visitation with the priest is necessary before scheduling a date for the Baptism of the child.

\*Those parents not registered in our parish must have written permission from their pastor to have their child Baptized in our church.

These guidelines are given in order to insure continued growth and participation in the Catholic faith and the Church community.



## Diocese of Cheyenne Feasibility Study EXECUTIVE SUMMARY



Through this sacred journey, the Diocese of Cheyenne reminds us of our efforts to enliven our mission through co-responsibility, participation, and communion. It is through our unity, collaboration, and shared commitment to communion for mission that we can truly fulfill our calling.

In January 2024, the Diocese of Cheyenne partnered with CCS Fundraising to conduct a feasibility and planning study seeking input and guidance from clergy and laity on a proposed diocesan-wide capital campaign in support of parishes, diocesan ministries, and partner organizations. The study received feedback through 79 personal interviews (41 clergy and 38 laity) and 968 e-survey responses from across the diocese providing valuable insights to discern a path forward for the diocese. CCS would like to acknowledge and thank each of the study participants for their time, candid thoughts, and valuable advice.

Key findings from the study are shared below.

### SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

A majority of both clergy and laity have a positive or very positive perception of the diocese. They also have a largely positive or very positive reaction to the proposed plans. In particular, interviewees noted the proposed parish share (25% of parish funds raised) is an incentive to support this effort.


This positivity is largely due to Bishop Steven's leadership and accessibility mentioned as key strengths of the diocese.


The potential case elements of Strengthening our Parishes and Seminarian Education Endowment ranked as the highest priorities among study participants; helping to further define those elements that would garner financial support.

A strong majority of clergy said they would be willing to engage in key aspects of campaign planning and execution. This level of positivity outperforms peer dioceses in other recent CCS studies.

Similarly, **laity also demonstrated a high willingness to become involved** as volunteers, leaders, and donors.

A majority of interviewees recommended that the diocese moves forward with a campaign and that now is the time to proceed. Interviewees also noted that a period of preparation and planning is key to success.

## KEY RECOMMENDATIONS

Launch a campaign with a recommended aspirational working goal of \$36 Million. This would include:

- · lead gift phase goal of \$11 Million,
- parish phase goal of \$15 Million payable over five years, and
- planned gifts and blended gift requests with a \$10 Million goal.

The parish phase goal of \$15 million is based on 150% of one year's total offertory income spread over five years.

**Position Bishop Steven to serve as the spiritual and visible leader** of the campaign, uniting the Catholic community, partners, and faithful in communion for mission.

Commit to a campaign planning and activation phase to begin foundational organizing efforts immediately.

Implement a parish share of 25%.

**Resource the campaign initiative appropriately** to provide immersive support and partnership across the diocese for parishes, diocesan ministries, and partner organizations. Place dedicated resources toward campaign planning, lead gifts phase, dedicated campaign communications, and hand-in-glove local parish support.

**Initiate a robust lead gifts focus** to include cultivation and gift requests of potential donors with the capacity to consider high 6- and 7-figure commitments. Engage partner organizations in collaborative gift efforts with Bishop Steven.

Convene key advisory teams to support Bishop Steven and the goals of the campaign.

**Advance Christ's Mission** and create a culture of gratitude and generosity and open hearts to more intentional discipleship.

The Diocese of Cheyenne is truly blessed and grateful for the participation of so many faithful in this process. We are thankful for your support and guidance throughout this process. This study has helped us discern a path forward to gather the resources we need to fulfill our vision for our communities of faith.
