


Immediately following the Mass, please join the newest priest of the Diocese of Cheyenne for a **reception in Hartmann Hall**.

#### Please Pray for Wyoming Judges.

On April 16, 2025, the Wyoming Supreme Court will hear oral arguments on the constitutionality of two state laws restricting abortion. While these laws remain under judicial review, abortion is still legal in Wyoming. In response, the Wyoming Legislature passed two additional bills in March 2025, one requires an ultrasound to determine the unborn child's age and location before abortion pills may be dispensed; the other requires admitting privileges at a hospital for any provider performing surgical abortions. These laws also will be subject to judicial review. Please pray that the Lord bless Wyoming judges with courage, wisdom, prudence, and integrity. May every human life, regardless of age or circumstance, be protected under Wyoming law.

It is time for the annual Pastoral Council elections. Nominations should be submitted directly to Fr. Clark by May 5. Nominees will be vetted and the election for the two open spots on the council will be held on the weekend of June 1. Pastoral Council members serve 3-year terms, with a maximum of 4 consecutive terms.

Per diocesan statutes, to be eligible to serve on the Pastoral Council, members must be:

- 1. registered in the parish
- 2. fully initiated into the Catholic Church
- 3. in good standing with the Church
- 4. outstanding in firm faith, good morals and prudence
- 5. willing to work with parishioners of all ages and backgrounds

# INFANT BAPTISM GUIDELINES

As a Christian Community we bring forth these guidelines regarding the Sacrament of infant Baptism. Since this is a Sacrament of Initiation (introduction) to the Catholic Community the following must take place:

\*The parents must be registered at Our Lady of Fatima, and be consistently seen attending Mass in this church.

\*If this is the first child, the parent (s) must attend a Baptismal Preparation class.

\*Godparents must be Baptized, Confirmed, and practicing Catholics. One Godparent is required. If for good reason the Godparent is from out of town, or another Catholic church in town, a letter from his/her pastor is required stating that he/she is a practicing member in good standing.

\*A visitation with the priest is necessary before scheduling a date for the Baptism of the child.

\*Those parents not registered in our parish must have written permission from their pastor to have their child Baptized in our church.

These guidelines are given in order to insure continued growth and participation in the Catholic faith and the Church community.
